

MGC Visitors' charges 2011 – 2012

Visitors' charges apply to visiting members of BGA or overseas gliding clubs and air cadets.

Visitors' temporary membership

Visitors must be temporary members and pay a 'facility fee' for every day they are on site:

- Visiting pilots, including juniors **£8 per day or £40 per week**
- Persons accompanying visiting pilots **£1 per day or £5 per week.**

Visitors' flying fees

The MGC charges visitors a flat daily "flying fee" to use club aircraft.

Payment of the visitors' flying fee gives visiting temporary members the same rights to use club aircraft as MGC members, but no priority over them. Aircraft are allocated according to demand by the duty instructor at the morning briefing.

- Site check **£12**
- Flying fee (single-seat gliders only) **£24/day**
- Flying fee (two-seat + single-seat gliders) **£48/day**

The flying fee for two-seat gliders applies per aircraft whether flown by two visitors or one visitor and an MGC instructor

Launches are charged in addition to the flying fee at members' rates (see below)

Aircraft hire

Exclusive use of an MGC glider (prior booking required, subject to approval of the MGC committee)

Two-seater with/without an instructor **£96 /day**

Single-seater **£60 /day**

Visitors' launch fees

- Winch or bungee **£9**
- Junior visitors (under 21) / air cadets **£4.50**
- Aerotow. 2000' £28 3000' £36 4000' £45

Trailer Hitches

Visitors bringing their own aircraft pay a trailer hitch fee

£4 per day or £20 per week

Hangarage (when available)

£10 per night or £50 per week

Visiting power pilots' landing fees

£10 per landing (strictly PPR and at the Club's discretion)
